**SUBJECT: Collection of Real-World Emission Data for reporting to the European Commission**

European regulation of the “Real-World Emission Data” (“data” in the following) collection and reporting to the European Commission has been published as official journal, and this regulation entry into force from March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021 for vehicles which newly registered on and after January 1st, 2021.

This regulation state that such data should be collected as soon as it becomes available, as it is essential to identify, as early as possible, how the difference between the real-world emissions and fuel or energy consumption and the corresponding type-approval values evolves over time, both for monitoring the effectiveness of the CO2 emission standards in reducing vehicle CO2 emissions, and for informing the public.

To comply with the regulation, Suzuki Factory such as Suzuki Motor Corporation in Japan (SMC) and Magyar Suzuki Corporation Ltd. in Hungary (MSC) will collect the data from your vehicle and report it to the European Commission.

<Kind of data in your vehicle>

- Vehicle Identification Number (VIN)
- Date for collecting consumption figures
- Total amount of fuel used (lifetime measurement)
- Total distance travelled (lifetime measurement)

In case of PHEV (Plug-in Hybrid Electric Vehicle), following data will be additionally collected.

- Total distance traveled in charge depleting operation with engine off (Lifetime)
- Total distance traveled in charge depleting operation with engine running (Lifetime)
- Total distance traveled in driver-selectable charge increasing operation (Lifetime)
- Total fuel consumed in charge depleting operation (Lifetime)
- Total fuel consumed in driver-selectable charge increasing operation (Lifetime)
- Total grid energy into the battery (Lifetime)

<Way of data collection>

When you bring your vehicle to the Suzuki authorized dealers for any maintenances and/or any repairs, they will collect the data from your vehicle using the Suzuki’s diagnostic tool. Then they will transfer the collected data to Suzuki Factory via Suzuki Distributor.



<Data handling and storage period>

When data has been transferred to Suzuki Factory, the data at Suzuki authorized dealers and (Suzuki Distributor) in your country will be deleted at all.

Also, when data has been reported to the European Commission by April 1<sup>st</sup> of every year, the data at Suzuki Factory will be deleted immediately as well. Until that date, Suzuki Factory will store the data in secured server. For more information and details, please read the following Suzuki's Privacy Policies.
